Hereby applies to join the Kentucky Distillers' Association as a Heritage Member. While the KDA maintains an open membership policy, a licensed Distiller or Rectifier is considered a Heritage Member in good standing by abiding by all applicable KDA By-laws, federal, state and local laws and ordinances, and by paying annual dues. There is a one-time, non-refundable initiation and application fee of \$65,000. Annual dues are based on barrel inventory as of Dec. 31 the preceding year, and are calculated at a rate prescribed each year by the KDA Board of Directors. Minimum annual dues are \$25,000. The KDA Board of Directors, by majority vote, shall have the right and power to revoke, suspend or censure any Heritage Member's participation or membership for violation of these standards, the DISCUS code of ethics, or laws and regulations that govern standards of identity and aging and labeling requirements as set forth in accordance with KDA bylaws.
