KDA SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The "KDA Scholars" program benefits Black, LGBTQIA+, women, people of color and other traditionally underrepresented groups. It is currently funding credit hours in certificate programs directly related to the distilling industry at three state universities: University of Louisville, University of Kentucky, and Kentucky State University.

The group also is working to expand these scholarships to other Kentucky educational institutions in order to increase opportunities for young professionals so they can launch meaningful careers in Kentucky's Bourbon and distilled spirits industry.

The KDA has received tremendous support from its membership in funding these scholarships and engaging KDA Scholars. Most recently, The Wild Turkey Distilling Co. and Russell's Reserve Bourbon donated \$20,000 to the KDA's Lifting Spirits Foundation, which will fund KDA Scholars certificate program credit hours at participating institutions.
